Cllr B Kaushiva was a no show again (2) and had not given any apology for absence. Cllr F Heptonstall (WMDC Ward 5) had previously given her apology for absence.

- **SAFE Scheme & Police matters** The latest report was reviewed noting that the specialist traffic PC had issued 8 speeding tickets in one tour of duty on 17.6.24. It was also noted that many Walton-based Facebook users had reported the PC's presence to alert to other road users.
- 32 Wakefield MDC Ward 5 Councillor update

Cllr Cummings shared information on the average speeds on School Lane (25.8mph), Shay Lane (23.9mph & 33.1mph), Common Lane (38.3mph), Greenside (33mph) noting that no action would follow.

Cllr Cummings advised that the following planning application would be considered by WMDC Planning Committee on 18.7.24...

23/00157/OUT - Land to East Of Nevile Drive, The Grove, Walton - Outline application for erection of 35 no. continuing care apartments. The Chair and Cllr Cummings confirmed that they would be attending and speaking.

Cllr Cummings advised that all recent incidents of local overhanging branches & trees causing a nuisance to pavement and road users had been reported to WMDC Highways and the landowners advised to trim back.

Cllr Cummings advised that WMDC is in the process of implementing a School Keep Clear – Traffic Regulation Order which will improve traffic safety outside schools throughout the district. These proposals will allow for correct enforcement by Civil Enforcement Officers using Automatic Number Plate Recognition means – improving safety and reducing the volume of stationery traffic within the 'safety critical areas' of a school.

An inspection of the Park playground area has been carried out by two WMDC inspectors and passed.

WMDC have confirmed verbally that a Xmas tree can be planted on the strip of land between Shay Lane and Cherry Tree Drive. Written confirmation detailing specifications awaited.
