Patrols:

PC 3613 VENNING Reports

Safe scheme Patrol made on Off Road Motorcycle on 17/10/2024 Between 14:30- 16:30 hours.

Patrol of the parish made on Off Road Motorcycle, all carriageways moving with no obstructions, Patrol of the nature reserve made, and all vehicles in the car park checked, all in order.

I spent an hour of my patrol, sat next to the primary school during pick up time, my presence, slowed down vehicles, and prompted parents to park vehicles in a more considerate manner. I was approached by a number of parents who were picking their children up who thanked me for my presence , as it made them feel safer.

Later in my shift, i was approached by a member of public who informed me that the EVRI driver of van 92, had dumped a large amount of parcels at various location in the village, these parcels were brought to the PREMIER store for safe keeping but they refused to take them. Local EVRI driver flagged down and they agreed to take the parcels and return them to the depot.

PC Steel reports,

Patrols made on off road motorbike on 9th October between 14:00 X 16:00.

I first patrolled the area up around the Balk, including areas where previous damage had been caused. I didn't see anyone however just wanted to make sure there was no evidence of hotspots where youth had been gathering. There were no issues at all.

I then patrolled around the canal and woods where I spoke to several dog walkers. No sightings or tracks to suggest any issues. The gate near Anglers Country Park which had previously allowed access for bikes towards Walton was ow locked shut so this obviously stopes any bikes coming through.

As usual I also patrolled the Nature Reserve using the bike, again no problems and no new bike tracks. I then finished off my shift around Oakenshaw Lane. Numerous vehicles checked, and all were in order.

PC Steel reports,

Patrols made on off road motorbike on 08/10/2024 between 14:00 x 16:00.

Initially spent time monitoring traffic along Oakenshaw from several different points. No issues sighted. Whilst in and around that area I patrolled the nature reserve. Car Park was very busy with cars belonging to people using the nature reserve. Absolutely no problems at all. Traffic monitored along Shay Lane along with the area around the school. No issues regarding parking, however I did sight one driver driving erratically. As I approached the vehicle to stop it, it transpired the driver was using their phone whilst driving. Ticket issued to the driver.

No other issues.

PC VENNING Reports

Safe Scheme patrol made on off road motorcycle on the 02/10/2024 between 13:00 - 15:00 hrs.

I spent most of my patrol in the nature reserve, a number of dog walkers spoke to with some mentioning that they had seen an off road motorcycle in the reserve, a good prolonged search was conducted but nothing was located, however fresh tracks located around the pond area. Reserve car park checked and all in order.

No calls to service while on duty.

PC 1845 Blore reports

Safe scheme patrol carried out 01/10/2024 between 13:30 x 15:30 both mobile and foot.

Usual areas patrolled during the above time however the weather was particularly bad so there was very little footfall or movement around the parish.

Mobile patrol around Elmwood and Brookfield's estates nothing of note to report.

Golf carpark patrolled which was quiet again due to the weather with only a couple of vehicles in the car park.

Nature reserve patrolled on foot but the conditions were bad due to the heavy rain the previous days again not much footfall in the area.
